My Dear Mr. Antrim:

In today's edition of the San Diego Union I noticed one Mrs. Powell has protested against making your proposed ordinance.

This lady writes that free dogs are a nuisance. I certainly wish Mrs. Powell had to work in a machine shop from 4 P.M. to 12.01 A.M. then come back to this Camp and try to sleep 7 or 8 hours as one should.

Dogs run here in packs, not much is being done to curb their liberty. One trailer here has 3 people and 6 dogs in it, and they run loose most of the time. Most trailers are not disinfected when the tenant moves out, and some other poor devil has to bring their clothes and bedding into this flea ridden place.

If Mrs. Powell has a dog and cares for same, it won't be any hardship on her to take care of it. I would pass an ordinance requiring all persons owning a dog to pay at least \$5.00 license, and then you won't have so many stray dogs.

also I say pass an ordinance with teeth in it and any dog caught loose anywhere on public property or even loose require that it be shot, and also fine the owner another \$25.00. I am not a dog hater but I simply do not believe I should be allowed to own an animal that is a nuisance to the other fellow.

I have a good job and don't want my name published for several reasons. My wife and I are trying hard to leave this camp but so far have had little success.

I would like a decent nights sleep tho. Today I counted 16 dogs in one pack here in this camp loose, and they were doing plenty of yapping.

also Many of these people have to work the graveyard shift 12:00 A.M. to 8 or 8:30 a.m.

Now and not after the War is the time to stop this nuisance, We need our sleep. We are asked to work regular and long days, yet if someone's pet sits under your trailer or parks in the alley near where you are trying to sleep and wants to yap all nite, according to Mrs. Powell you should do Nothing about it.

Finally in desperation someone poisons a few and then he is labeled a fiend.

Have Mrs. Powell visit this Camp and see for herself. it is now 11 P.M. and the dogs are loose here and doing plenty of barking.





