

- WHEREAS: At the residence of Mr. Fred Scripps, located at the north end of Mission Beach, there are being maintained cows and various barnyard fowls, whose noisy bawling, crowing, cackling and so on, continue throughout the nights, which is most disturbing to the many residents of the community, at least some two hundred people.
- WHEREAS: This barnyard condition has caused the breeding of large flies, which settle in and around the neighborhood. Also odors emanating from said barnyard are most unhealthy and offensive.
- WHEREAS: This condition has caused a marked decrease of property values, and in at least one instance has prevented a sale.
- WHEREAS: Notice has been given the owner of these obnoxious conditions, and also petition with the names of many signers, who are residents and property owners in this community, has been presented to the District Attorney and Board of Health, and up to the present time the owner has ignored all suggestions as to the elimination of this Public Nuisance maintained by him.

Now therefore be it RESOLVED that our Mission Beach Woman's Club, always alert in the interest of the health and betterment of the entire district, ask that these evils be immediately abated, and that a copy of this Resolution has been sent to Mr. Fred Scripps, the District Attorney, the Board of Health, the Common Council of the City of San Diego, also Mr. Mason, President of the Chamber of Commerce.
