In reference to Document No. 163303 "a petition for suppression of a livery stable at 4237 First Street", which was referred to me for investigation, I beg to report the following:

The building referred to is located on the brow of the canyon at the north end of First Street. This place was abandoned recently by request of this department. The present lessee Mr. F. W. Robinson has occupied the premises for about 15 days, keeps eight to ten horses; the building is not constructed in a manner required by Ordinance #6383; the location is objectionable on account of this being a residential district. Therefore, I would recommend that the application for a permit to operate a public stable at this location be denied and that the applicant, Mr. F. W. Robinson be given a reasonable time to find a more suitable location.
