Gentlemen:

The Planning Commission is returning, herewith, Document 249779, a petition requesting that the special permit for a stable on Lot 18, Catalina Villas, be rescinded. This permit was granted by the Council subject to the approval of the Planning Commission, and the building is well under way.

Most of the protestants own property on the high bluff north and west of Catalina Villas, and our investigation of the matter on the ground seems to show that a riding club in which sanitary conditions are maintained would affect this property very little. The present building is hardly visible from the property of most of the protestants, and the prevailing winds blow in the opposite direction.
