ORDINANCE No. 9

Prohibiting use of

River for washing etc

(Repealed)

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of San Diego.

That whereas the health of the City is one of the most important considerations of its Citizens, and whereas pure and wholesome water is conducive to health and as requisite for its maintenance as the air we breathe and that in order to obtain pure water all persons are hereby prohibited from throwing dead animals or any deteriorous matter into the river running through the City, or from washing clothes or other articles in said river above the lower crossing to the playa - Any person so offending shall forfeit and pay to the City a fine of Five dollars, for each offence, or be set to work on the public works for three days; or shall be let or hired for the shorest (sic) space of time to the person or persons who will pay the amount of fine & costs, at the discretion of the Mayor of the City.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of San Diego,


