The cesspool on the west side of 19th. St. between B. St. and C. St. has been covered and is now in a sanitary condition.

In conclusion have to state that our records show no complaints from either of these neighborhoods for a period of more than two months last past. Whenever complaints are received by this Department relative to unsanitary conditions, they receive prompt attention.
