Gentlemen.

Some time ago I left with Mr Wright, City Clerk, a teachers bulletin, for each of you in regards to the English Sparrow. This bulletin speaks for itself. Mr John Jenks has kept this bird down until this year when there has been nothing done. San Diego County is becoming alive with them every town South of Ocean side and east to Ramona has them and becoming scattered all over the County. Mr Frank Stephens of the Society of Natural History in Balboa Park says this bird hatches from seven to nine months a year. If nothing done, in two years they will be so thick it will be impossible to keep them down. The Northern part of the State would give anything to be rid of the pest. Mr Jenks says for \$50<sup>00</sup> he will get the most of them in the City. I think the County should assist also. It is up to you to have them or not.
