Mr. President and Gentlemen;-

The undersigned is a resident and property owner at the address given below.

A number of months ago there was established by Mr. Roland Wilkie, on the property adjoining me to the south, namely 4121 Kansas St., a pigeon and poultry farm, comprising approximately 75 to 100 pigeons, a number of Pheasants and chickens.

This property is a 37½ Ft. City lot in a fully built up residential district, and due to the very close proximity of these pigeons to our living quarters they have become a public nuisance to us as well as creating a very unsanitary condition.

Their constant Cooing which starts in the early morning hours just at the break of dawn, disturbing our sleep, and continuing constantly all day until after dark at night has become unbearable.

I therefore earnestly seek your aid in having this nuisance abated.

I am reluctant to cause any inconvenience to a neighbor, but as Mr. Wilkie has a steady position, he is not dependent upon the income from these pigeons for his livelihood.

I have been informed by the Police Dept. that this situation is outside their jurisdiction. I am therefore seeking your aid in giving us relief in having this nuisance abated.
