San Diego, California.

Gentlemen:

Herewith I beg to return document No. 150858, a petition from residents in the vicinity of 4251 Third Street, relative to the abatement of an alleged nuisance at that number.

Recent inspections have been made of the premises at 4251 Third Street, and while the chickens are maintained within the law, and every effort is being made to keep the place as sanitary as possible, yet there is always danger from flies that are usually found in numbers about such places, and furthermore, I consider that the noise and odors emanating from these chicken pens are a nuisance.

The Health Department does not approve of chickens in such large numbers, being confined and cared for in a closely built up residence district.
