

WHEREAS, the extensive hog-pens of the Pueblo Farm, situated near La Jolla, are largely responsible for a very serious plague of flies which has afflicted this community for several months, and are likewise responsible for the prevalence of an intolerable stench, which is perceptible even at this distance, when the wind blows in the right direction; and

WHEREAS, such conditions constitute a menace to health, a source of extreme mental and physical discomfort, and an injury to local business interests; and

WHEREAS, conditions such as these seem inevitable, so long as great numbers of hogs are kept in this neighborhood and are fed upon the city's garbage, and could be only slightly ameliorated by any attempt to clean up or disinfect the premises; and

WHEREAS, a resolution passed more than a week ago by the Woman's Club of La Jolla, and sent to City Manager F.A. Rhodes, has met with no acknowledgement from him, but merely called forth an indignant denial, reported in the San Diego Union, in which he is quoted as saying that "as hog ranches go, it is in very good condition," and that "the flies of La Jolla do not come from the city farm";

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Parent Teacher's Association of La Jolla that it respectfully petitions the Common Council of the city of San Diego to order the City Manager to discontinue the raising of hogs in the present or any other region in which they will become a nuisance to this community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these resolutions be read at the meeting of the La Jolla Civic League, to be held this evening, and that copies of the same be sent to the Mayor of San Diego and to each of the San Diego and La Jolla newspapers.
