Over the week end, beginning Fri night
this night's hood (Pincalle Ave & 4th Sts
for blocks around) was disturbed by a
pack of 2 sep mad dogs following a female dog.
Calls to the Humane Society Sat. morning
brought no relief - these dogs in my yard
2 nights, when I came home about 10 P.M.
stood me off & would not allow me to enter
my yard & house. I had to walk around
until they chose to move on.

A call to the police Sun. night brought
no help. I was told by the man answer-
ing the phone call, "Go chase them off
myself." When I said I was afraid
them for one barked so viciously - he
said "Have your husband do it" - he
fortunately I am not equipped with one.
I protest that there is no co-operation
from police & Humane Society in an

emergencies like this. The humane society
not working at night. An incident was going
to pieces on a front porch of another
home. This might have happened
to a child or adult who happened to
be in their way.

I urge upon you that an ordinance
be passed requiring the Society
to have a record of the owners of all dogs
that in a case like this the owner
be required to buy them in when
the call of the wild & act against them.
That dogs be kept on leash & not
allowed to make a toilet on lawns other
than their own. Many owners deliberately
take their dogs to other grounds than their
own on leash ^{for their own} in other activities of the
U. S. A. such ordinances are in fact.
This is "clean up" season - let's have
help in cleaning up our lawns by
prevention of ^{the} ~~defilement~~ ^{defilement} by dogs.
Again I call to your attention the
